CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT ELECTION***

CALL MEETING TO ORDER & ESTABLISH QUORUM – 9:04 a.m. – Shuffield Absent

Sherry Mueck, Election Clerk reviewed the Canvass Report including information regarding the voting locations for the County Wide Voting.

- **County wide voting locations = Precincts 101, 105, 207, 212, 316, 317, 318 and 420.**
- **No voting at Precincts 203, 210 and 419**
- **Registered Voters = 13,989**
- **Total Number of Voters 11/5/15 = 1,402**
- **Early Voting turnout = 29.2%**

Motion by Commissioner Muegge, seconded by Commissioner Watkins to accept the November 03, 2015 Constitutional Amendment Election Canvass. This motion having been put to vote prevailed, the vote being unanimous.

Other discussion:

Mueck – even though we were down to eight voting locations we still had difficulties getting workers. The Friday & Monday before the election two Judges notified me they would not be able to work.

Judge – do we know how many residents are under the age of 18?

Mueck & Vansa – Census bureau would probably have that information.

Vansa – to the Court: Do any of you have questions or comments for us?

- **Student Workers – Since it became law we started using student workers - they are very knowledge with technology.**
 - **Students must apply and have permission from their school to participate in the Election voting process.**
- **County wide polling – Muegge & Watkins stated they voted at locations other than their precinct because of convenience.**

ADJOURN – Motion by Commissioner Muegge, seconded by Commissioner Watkins to adjourn @ 9:13 A.M. This motion having been put to vote prevailed, the vote being unanimous.
