

# Notice of Tax Revenue Increase

The MILAM COUNTY conducted public hearings on August 22, 2011 and September 7, 2011 on a proposal to increase the total tax revenues of the MILAM COUNTY from properties on the tax roll in the preceding year by 3.425094 percent.

The total tax revenue raised last year at last year's tax rate of 0.600000 for each \$100 of taxable value was \$10,995,267.85.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised this year at the proposed tax rate of 0.600000 for each \$100 of taxable value, excluding tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year, is \$11,502,650.48.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised this year at the proposed tax rate of 0.600000 for each \$100 of taxable value, including tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year, is \$11,585,554.76.

The Commissioners Court is scheduled to vote on the tax rate that will result in that tax increase at a public meeting to be held on September 12, 2011 at Milam County Courthouse, 102 S. Fannin, Cameron, Tx 76520 at 10:00 AM
